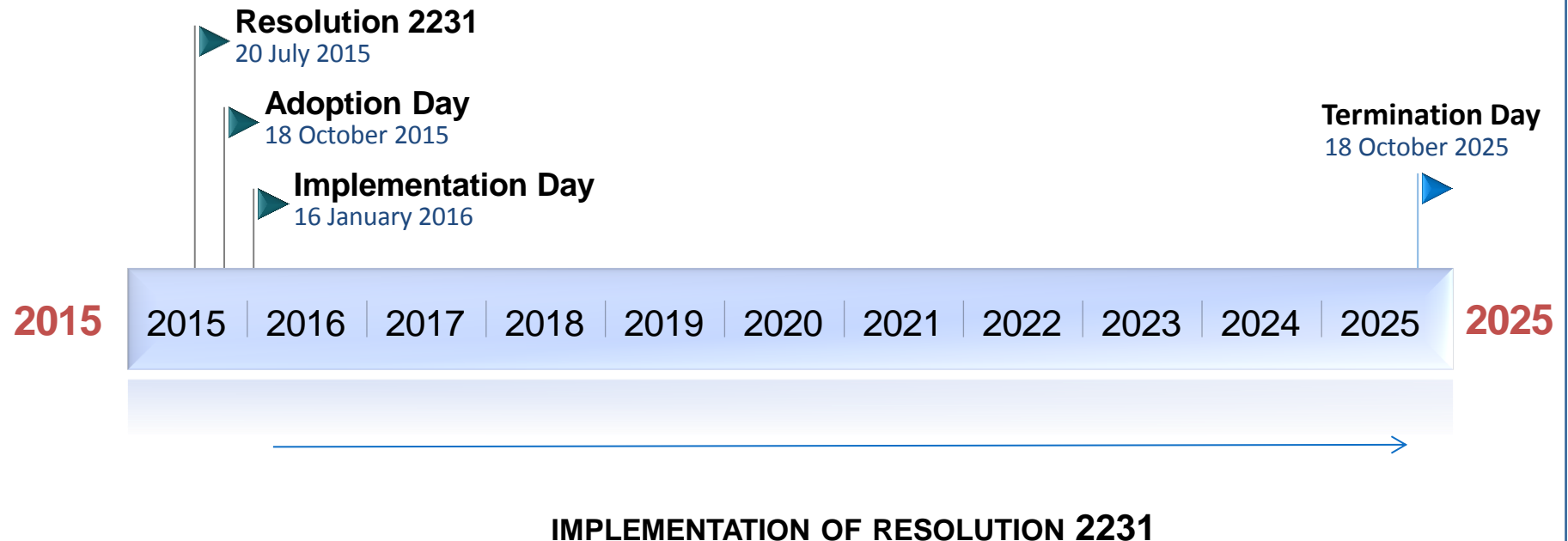

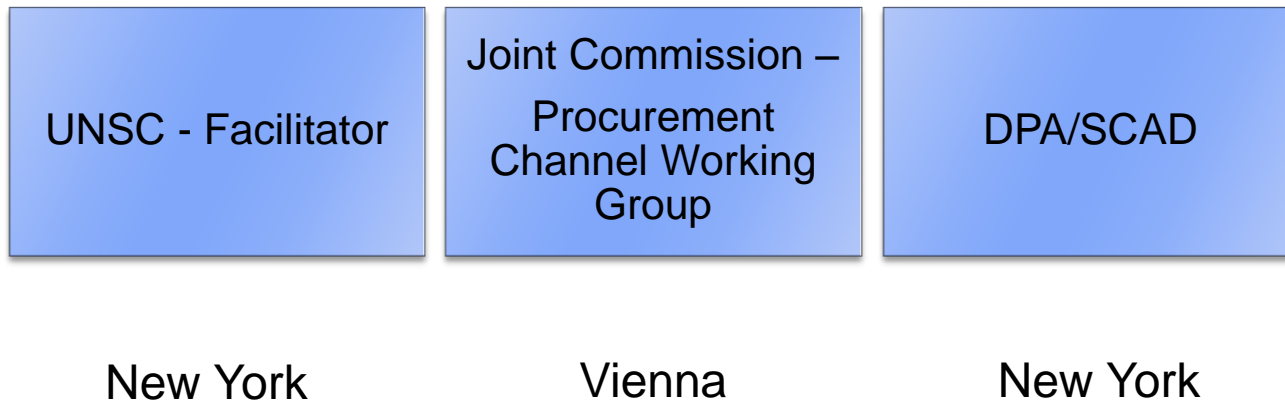

Any further items which could contribute to activities inconsistent with the JCPOA

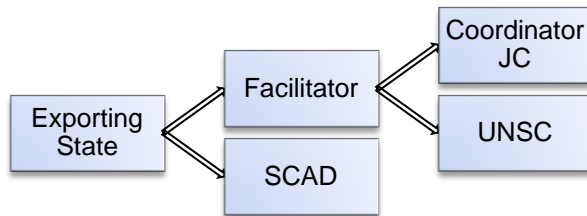
Provision to Iran of any related assistance

Acquisition by Iran of an interest in certain commercial nuclear-related activity in another State

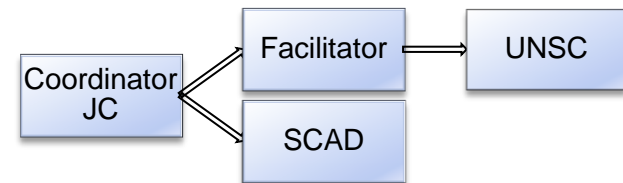

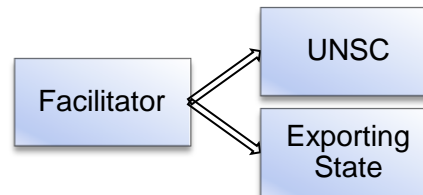

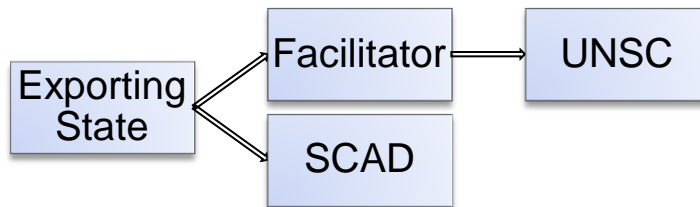

1. Proposal



There is no optional application form.

2. Final decision by the UNSC

The UNSC decides on a case-by-case basis.

3.C) EXCEPTIONS: PROCEDURE

2. What is the procedure for the exceptions?

Exception (a)

Light water reactors

- States notify the UNSC Facilitator within 10 days of the transaction

Exception (b)

Arak, Fordow, enriched uranium

- States notify the UNSC Facilitator and the JC 10 days in advance

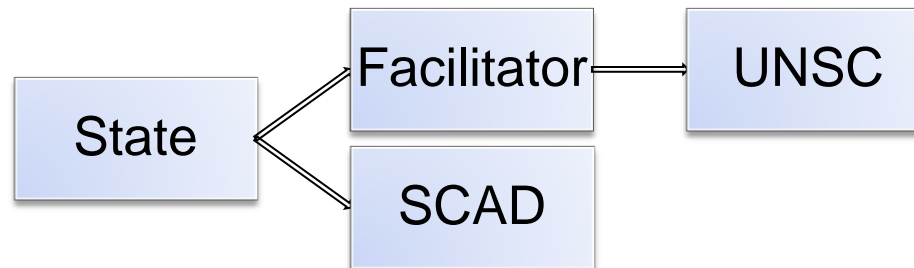
