Statement by Javier SOLANA, EU High Representative for the CFSP, on the Iranian nuclear file following consultations among the E3 +3

Javier Solana, EU High Representative for the Common Foreign and Security Policy (CFSP), made the following comments on the Iranian nuclear dossier following consultations between representatives of the E3 + 3 countries (France, Germany, UK, China, Russia, US).

"I have received the Iranian paper and am studying it. We are all committed to meaningful negotiations with Iran to resolve the International Community's concerns about their nuclear programme. This is in the context of considerable efforts made over a long time by the 3+3 and the framework of their two track policy.

We are in contact with Dr Jalili's office to arrange a meeting at the earliest possible opportunity".
