Implementation of the NPT Safeguards Agreement and relevant provisions of United Nations Security Council resolutions in the Islamic Republic of Iran

Resolution adopted on 9 September 2026 during the 1821st session

The Board of Governors,¹

- (a) Commending the continued professional, independent, and impartial efforts of the IAEA Director General and the Secretariat, in implementing Iran's Treaty on the Non-Proliferation of Nuclear Weapons (NPT)-related Safeguards Agreement, INFCIRC/214, ("Safeguards Agreement") to resolve the outstanding safeguards issues in Iran, and to undertake verification activities as required by the relevant resolutions of the Board of Governors and the United Nations Security Council (UNSC),
- (b) Emphasizing the essential and independent role of the Agency in verifying compliance with safeguards obligations and in providing objective technical reporting to the Board and, as appropriate, in parallel to the UNSC,
- (c) Recalling the resolutions adopted by the Board on June 12, 2025, contained in GOV/2025/38, and on June 10, 2026, contained in GOV/2026/40, regarding Iran's non-compliance with its obligations under its Safeguards Agreement with the Agency in the context of Article XII.C of the Agency's Statute, and reaffirming the findings of the Board contained in those resolutions,
- (d) Also recalling the resolution adopted by the Board on November 21, 2025, contained in GOV/2025/71,

- (e) Noting with grave concern the Director General's report contained in GOV/2026/50 that documents Iran's continued non-compliance with its obligations, and stressing that the Agency's lack of information about previously declared nuclear material and access to facilities to verify it is a matter of proliferation concern and compliance with the Safeguards Agreement and needs to be addressed with the utmost urgency, and
- (f) Expressing continuing support for a diplomatic solution to the Iranian nuclear file and calling on Iran to engage seriously and without preconditions in talks aimed at building international confidence in the exclusively peaceful nature of Iran's nuclear programme,
1. Reiterates its call upon Iran to urgently remedy its non-compliance with its Safeguards Agreement by taking all steps deemed necessary by the Agency and the Board, so that the Director General can provide the necessary assurances regarding the correctness and completeness of Iran's declarations pursuant to its Safeguards Agreement and the non-diversion of nuclear material required to be safeguarded under the Agreement;
 2. Requests the Director General to report this resolution and the previously adopted resolutions contained in GOV/2025/38 and GOV/2026/40, as well as the Director General's report contained in GOV/2026/50, to all Members of the Agency and to the Security Council and the General Assembly of the United Nations, in accordance with the relevant provisions of the IAEA Statute;
 3. Stresses its support for a diplomatic solution to the challenges posed by the Iranian nuclear programme and its implications for regional and international peace and stability leading to an agreement that addresses all international concerns related to Iran's nuclear activities, and encourages relevant parties to constructively engage in diplomacy;
 4. Requests the Director General to continue to report before each regular quarterly Board meeting on the implementation of Iran's Safeguards Agreement, on the outstanding safeguards issues in Iran, and on the verification activities as required by the relevant resolutions of the Board of Governors and the United Nations Security Council, and to continue to provide such reports to the UNSC; and
 5. Decides to remain seized of the matter.
