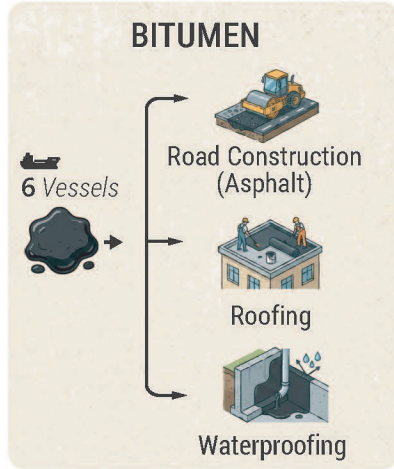
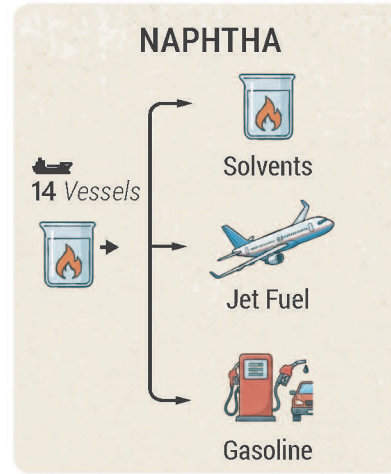


# Petroleum Products Transported by Iran's Shadow Fleet Vessels Identified in OFAC's Action

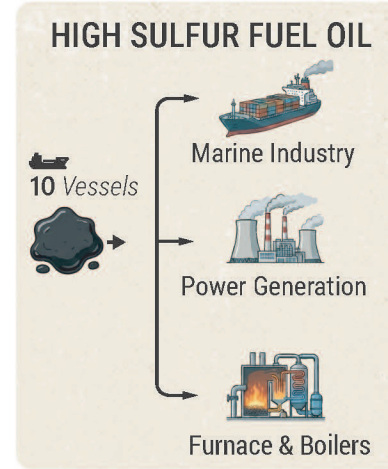

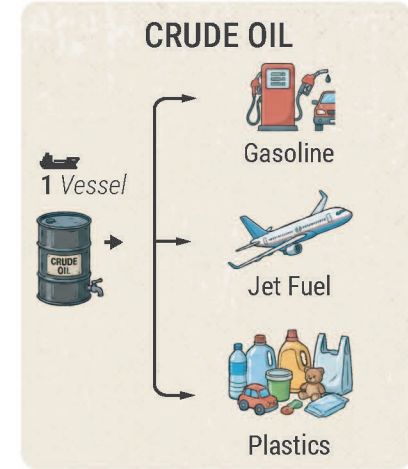
**Bitumen** is a dense, sticky, highly viscous hydrocarbon material derived from crude oil, commonly used to bind aggregates in road construction and other construction applications.



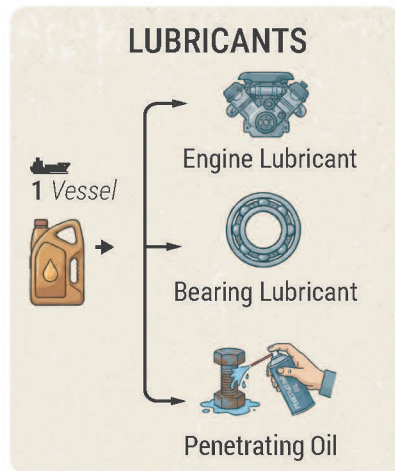
**Naphtha** is a flammable, colorless liquid derived from petroleum distillation, used as a solvent, fuel, and crucial feedstock for producing gasoline, plastics, and synthetic fibers.



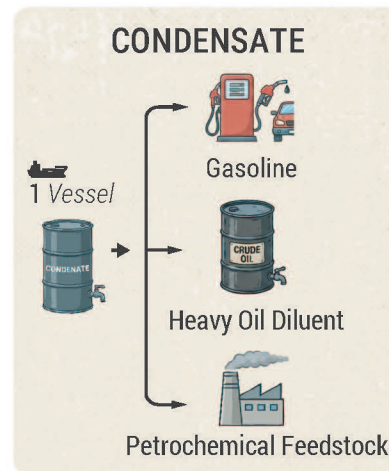
**High sulfur fuel oil (HSFO)** is a high sulfur content heavy fuel oil used largely in power generation and the maritime shipping industry.



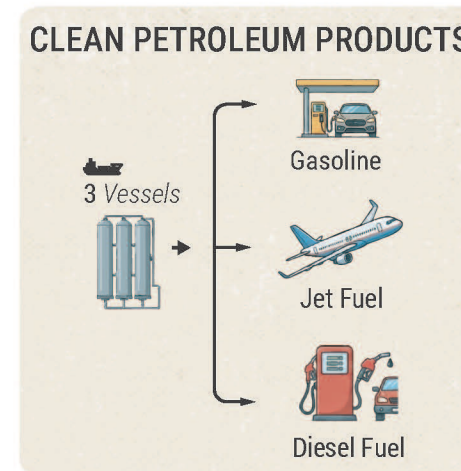
**Crude oil** is a naturally occurring, liquid fossil fuel extracted from the earth and refined into essential products like gasoline, jet fuel, and plastics.



**Lubricants** are substances refined from crude oil that are used to reduce friction between moving surfaces, as processing aids, or as carriers of other materials.



**Condensate** is a light hydrocarbon liquid that forms when natural gas cools during production or processing, yielding valuable components used as petrochemical feedstocks or blended into fuels.



**Clean petroleum products** are refined hydrocarbon fuels and solvents with low impurities, such as gasoline, diesel, and jet fuel, produced to meet strict standards for cleaner combustion.
