

SECURITY COUNCIL COMMITTEE ESTABLISHED  
PURSUANT TO RESOLUTION 1737 (2006)

Chairman's 90-day report to the Security Council  
delivered in consultations of the whole on 9 September 2009

1. This is the eleventh 90-day report to the Security Council in accordance with paragraph 18 (h) of resolution 1737 (2006). The report covers the period from 16 June 2009 to 9 September 2009, during which time the Committee held no meetings but conducted its work using the silence procedure.
2. In the previous report, I informed the Council that the Committee had sent letters to Member States involved in a transfer of arms-related materiel from Iran in violation of paragraph 5 of resolution 1747 (2007). The letters recalled these States' obligations under the UN Charter "to accept and carry out the decisions of the Security Council" and reiterated the Committee's request to provide any relevant information. To date, the Committee has not received a response to these letters. With respect to the same prohibited transfer of arms-related materiel, on 24 July 2009 the Committee approved the text of an "Implementation Assistance Notice", which contains information about the violation that might be useful to Member States in implementing their obligations under resolutions 1737 (2006), 1747 (2007) and 1803 (2008). The notice is now available on the Committee's web site.
3. During the reporting period, the Committee received a notification pursuant to paragraph 15 of resolution 1737 (2006) in connection with the unfreezing of funds to make a payment for a contract entered into prior to the listing of the entity. The Committee also responded to written queries from a Member State and the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 751 (1992) concerning Somalia.
4. Finally, with regard to reporting by States on the implementation of all relevant measures set out in resolutions 1737 (2006), 1747 (2007) and 1803 (2008), the updated figures are as follows: 91 reports under resolution 1737 (2006), 78 reports under resolution 1747 (2007) and 67 reports under resolution 1803 (2008).
